## PREPARATION and RESPONSE TO A MAJOR EARTHQUAKE

According to the USGS and other scientists, the probability of a Bay Area earthquake measuring 6.7 and capable of causing widespread damage before 2030 is 70%. The 6.7 Northridge earthquake caused 58 deaths, more than 9,000 injuries and more than \$49 billion in losses.

It may be years before a major earthquake impacts us, or it can happen next year, next month or next week. Our degree of preparation will have a direct impact on our outcomes.

Hear experts describe what to expect from Emergency Services, how to prepare your home and what to do after a major quake, what earthquake insurance is all about, and how to fortify ourselves and deal with the emotional impact of a major disaster.
