FIRE WATCH CONDITIONS/SIGNITURE FORM

2016 CFC - 901.7 Systems out of service

FIRE WATCH. A temporary measure intended to ensure continuous and systematic surveillance of a building or portion thereof by one or more qualified individuals for the purposes of identifying and controlling fire hazards, detecting early signs of unwanted fire, raising an alarm of fire and notifying the fire department.

- Fire watch personnel are to keep diligent watch for fires in the areas affected. The person or persons performing the fire watch are not to be permitted to perform any other duties. The building shall be patrolled at least once per hour on a 24-hour basis until the fire protection system has been restored to normal operating condition.
- Fire watch personnel shall notify occupants to evacuate when there is a fire in the area.
- Fire watch personnel are to have fire-extinguishing equipment readily available and be trained in its use.
