RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTHERN MARIN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO ADOPT THE SOUTHERN MARIN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ANNEX TO THE 2024 MULTI JURISDICTIONAL LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, natural hazards, such as earthquakes, floods, and wildfires, pose a significant threat to the residents and visitors of Southern Marin Fire Protection District; and

WHEREAS, disasters start and end at the local level, it is the inherent responsibility of local government to lead hazard mitigation and the reduction of risk and vulnerability to hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Southern Marin Fire Protection District, in coordination with neighboring jurisdictions and special districts, produced the Southern Marin Fire Protection District Annex to the 2024 Marin Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan to provide a framework for hazard mitigation; and

WHEREAS, the Southern Marin Fire Protection District Board adopted a new Safety Element into the District Plan in 2023 that incorporates by reference the Southern Marin Fire Protection District Annex to the 2024 Marin Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan by including the following language: “The Southern Marin Fire Protection District Annex to the 2024 Marin Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (herein referred to as the Southern Marin Fire Protection District Annex) complies with all requirements set forth under Disaster Mitigation Act (DMA) 2000 and includes information also relevant to the Safety Element. Sections of the Safety Element are supplemented by the most recently adopted Southern Marin Fire Protection District Annex, which is incorporated by reference, as allowed by California Government Code Section 65302(g). The Southern Marin Fire Protection District Annex presents environmental hazard analysis, describes important transportation and utility infrastructure at risk from environmental hazards, describes emergency evacuation systems, and mitigation actions to protect Marin County populations and infrastructure from environmental hazards.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Southern Marin Fire Protection District does hereby adopt the Southern Marin Fire Protection District Annex to the 2024 Marin County Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan:
